

## Metropolis Country Club Rules & Regulations

---

1. Golf carts and maintenance vehicles are the only vehicles authorized for use on the golf course.
2. No person under 16 years of age shall be permitted to operate an authorized vehicle at MCC, unless he or she is accompanied by a parent, grandparent, or legal guardian or is performing work as an employee of the club.
3. Personal golf carts may carry as many people as can be safely seated.
4. No golf cart trailers shall be parked, loaded or unloaded onto the black top parking lot. Please use the designated trailer parking area only.
5. No person shall drive golf carts off of the cart paths when the "Cart Path Only" sign is posted.
6. Golf carts may not be driven any closer to the green than the post by the green.
7. When the 90-degree rule is in affect, golf carts must be kept in the fairways as much as possible.
8. Golfers may not roll hand carts or set golf bags on the greens for any reason.
9. Children under age 12 are not permitted at MCC (in the clubhouse or on the course) unless accompanied by an adult.
10. MCC considers an adult to be at least 18 years of age.
11. Fivesomes will be allowed on weekdays all year. No more than a foursome on weekends and holidays from May 15th through Labor Day (unless approved for special club events). No more than a sixsome from November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 15<sup>th</sup>.
12. Members are responsible for payment of their guests' fees. Non-payment will result in an assessment fee for the member involved.
13. Members are responsible for any damages done to the club or golf course either by themselves or their guests.
14. Members must register their guests prior to play or as soon as the clubhouse opens for business.
15. Members and their dependants may not retrieve golf balls from the ponds either by seining or diving.
16. Metal spikes are not permitted on the golf course at any time.
17. Members and guests may not begin their round on any hole other than #1; unless approved by the pro-shop.
18. Green fees are for 18 holes only until after 5:00pm when 9 holes may be accepted.
19. Full shirts with sleeves must be worn at all times while on the golf course. Shirts may be removed only in the pool area. No tank tops will be allowed at MCC. Cover-ups must be worn in the clubhouse.
20. Practice balls may not be hit into the greens. Please use the designated shag range and practice green only. No shot shall be hit into the practice green that may leave a ball mark. Chipping is allowed only within 5 yards of the practice green. No more than 5 balls are allowed.
21. No outside tournaments may be held between May 15<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day. No outside tournaments may be held on the weekends, from Labor Day through September 30<sup>th</sup>. other than regularly scheduled club tournaments, without pre-approval by the Board of Governors.
22. Any commercial group outings, other than member's family outings, must be pre-approved by the Board of Governors.
23. Tobacco use is not permitted in the MCC clubhouse.
24. Golfers must be at least 14 years of age to participate in tournaments.
25. Non-members, bringing golf carts to play, will be charged \$15.00, unless the cart is for use in an MCC tournament.
26. Former members who were expelled for non-payment of dues must pay all accounts in arrears including late fees plus full initiation of \$400 in order to re-apply for membership.
27. Any person found breaking the rules and regulations at MCC will be issued the following warning, fine and/or suspension:

1<sup>st</sup> offense - warning

2<sup>nd</sup> offense - \$25.00 fine, suspension of club privileges until paid

3<sup>rd</sup> offense - \$25.00 fine and suspension of club privileges for 30 days

4<sup>th</sup> offense – suspension of club privileges for 6 months
