

# Metropolis Country Club Rules & Regulations

1. Golf carts and maintenance vehicles are the only vehicles authorized for use on the golf course.
2. No person under 16 years of age shall be permitted to operate an authorized vehicle at MCC, unless he or she is accompanied by a parent, grandparent, or legal guardian or is performing work as an employee of the club.
3. Personal golf carts may carry as many people as can be safely seated.
4. No golf cart trailers shall be parked, loaded or unloaded onto the black top parking lot. Please use the designated trailer parking area only.
5. No person shall drive golf carts off of the cart paths when the "Cart Path Only" sign is posted.
6. Golf carts must return to the cart path at green posts in front of greens. All carts must remain on the cart paths at all Tee Boxes.
7. When the 90-degree rule is in effect, golf carts must be kept in the fairways as much as possible.
8. Golfers may not roll hand carts or set golf bags on the greens for any reason.
9. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted at MCC (in the clubhouse or on the course) unless accompanied by an individual 18 years of age or older.
10. Fivesomes are allowed on weekdays all year. No more than a foursome is allowed on weekends and holidays from May 15th through Labor Day (unless approved for special club events). No more than a sixsome is allowed from November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 15th.
11. Members are responsible for payment of their guests' fees. Non-payment will result in an assessment fee for the member involved.
12. Members are responsible for any damages done to the club or golf course either by themselves or their guests.
13. Members must register their guests prior to play or as soon as the clubhouse opens for business.
14. Members and their dependants may not retrieve golf balls from the ponds by diving.
15. Metal spikes are not permitted on the golf course at any time.
16. Members and guests that do not begin their round on #1 must check the previous hole for other players. Players that have begun their round have the right of way and must be allowed to play through.
17. Full shirts with sleeves must be worn at all times while on the golf course. Shirts may be removed only in the pool area. No tank tops will be allowed at MCC. Cover-ups must be worn in the clubhouse.
18. Practice balls may not be hit into the greens. Please use the designated shag range. No shot shall be hit into the practice green that may leave a ball mark. Practice chipping is allowed only within 5 yards of the greens. No more than 3 balls are allowed and must not delay play.
19. No outside tournaments may be held between May 15th and Labor Day. No outside tournaments may be held other than regularly scheduled club tournaments without pre-approval by the Board of Governors.
20. Any commercial group outings, other than member's family outings, must be pre-approved by the Board of Governors.
21. Tobacco use is not permitted in the MCC clubhouse.
22. There will be zero tolerance for hitting into maintenance staff while conducting their daily duties.
23. Former members who were expelled for non-payment of dues must pay all accounts in arrears including late fees plus full initiation of \$400 in order to re-apply for membership
24. Any person found breaking the rules and regulations at MCC will be issued the following warning, fine and/or suspension:
  - 1st offense - warning
  - 2nd offense - \$25.00 fine, suspension of club privileges until paid
  - 3rd offense - \$25.00 fine and suspension of club privileges for 30 days
  - 4th offense – suspension of club privileges for 6 months<sup>1</sup>
